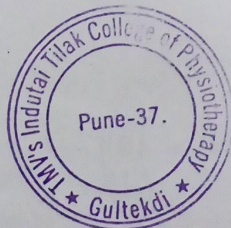
CLINICAL AREAS

The purpose of this Memorandum of Undertaking (MOU) is to formally create a mutually beneficial working relationship between Arise Vishwa Society (NGO) and Tilak Maharashtra Vidyapeeth's Indutai Tilak college of Physiotherapy on providing support for the physiotherapy care to the population in slums of PMC and PCMC

Background

About Arise Vishwa Society (NGO)

Arise Vishwa Society is a non government, constitutional rights based organization located in Pune. It is registered under the society' registration act' of 1860 & the Bombay Public Trust Act of 1950. The organization envision a world where every person irrespective of economic status is treated equally & has every right of survival, protection, development, & participation guranted by the country.

About Tilak Maharashtra Vidyapeeth's Indutai Tilak College Of Physiotherapy, Gultekdi, Pune

Tilak Maharashtra Vidyapeeth's Indutai Tilak College Of Physiotherapy, provides full time course of 4 years of education and 6 months of internship. Practical Patient training to students is provided in Campus-OPD and different esteemed tertiary care hospitals where students are exposed to variety of Cases. It becomes a great opportunity for the students to learn and practice in OPD and Hospitals under the guidance of Well-qualified staff.

The Concept

3. create awareness about physiotherapy, preventative & curative mean in the population
4. Wellmaintained health record of each subject will be done through physiotherapy screening for future follow-up
5. If needed for advanced treatment, respective subject shall be referred to tertiary care hospital
