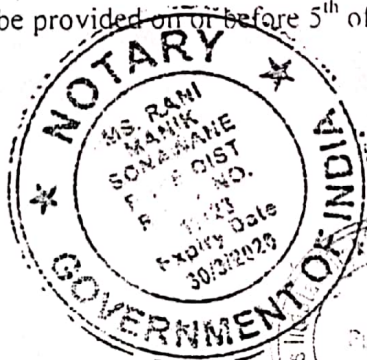
CLINICAL AREAS

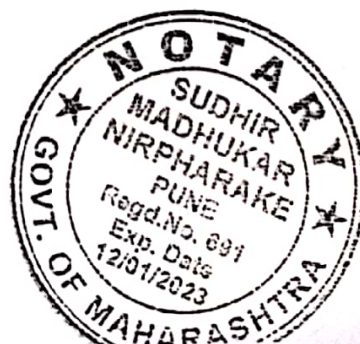
CLINICAL AREAS
